In June of this year, SarcoidosisUK joined a number of organisations in signing a [letter](#) to the Secretary of State regarding the change in the delivery of post-exposure treatments for COVID-19. The delivery of post-exposure treatments was moved from the Covid Medicine Delivery Units (CMDU's) to Integrated Care Boards (ICB's). The letter voiced our concerns about the uncertainty and potential issues this change would cause.

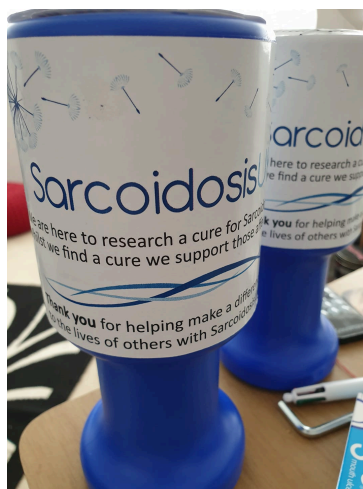
