Registrations Open for the Sarcoidosis Patient Day!

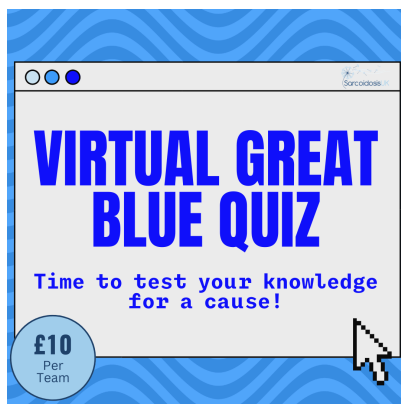

Thank you to our Amazing Fundraisers!

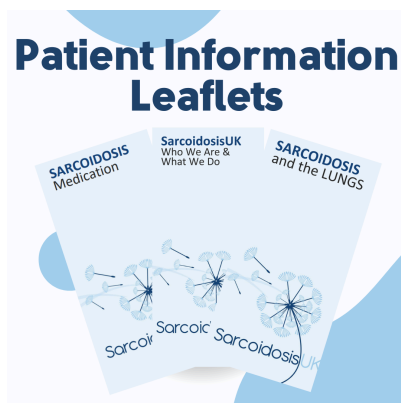
SarcoidosisUK would like to say a huge thank you to all of our amazing August fundraisers, including:

Did you know that we collaborated with the Royal College of GPs to develop a free module about sarcoidosis diagnosis and management?

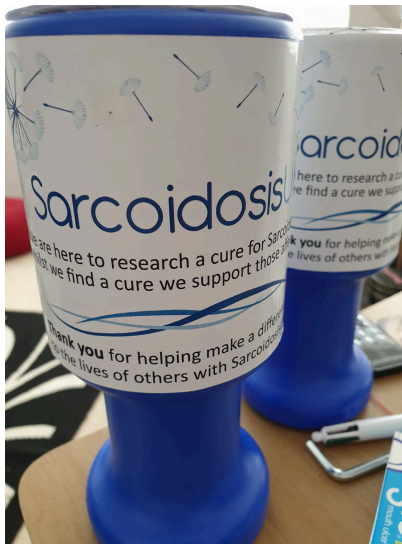
